

## The Teranishi Fellowship in Food Chemistry: How to apply

1. There is no special application form. The applicant should submit one original and four copies of the research proposal for consideration by the committee. It should be typed on standard 8" x 11" paper, and must be no longer than 2 pages.
2. The application must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation (one original and four copies) from the faculty member with whom the proposed research will be done. In addition, at least one other letter, but no more than three, from professor(s) at the student's undergraduate institution must be supplied.
3. Please supply the following information:
  - a. General (on a cover page to the proposed research project)
    - i. Name (first, middle initial, last name)
    - ii. Current address, please include zip code
    - iii. Telephone, please include area code
    - iv. Graduate status at time of application
    - v. Name and location of college or university
    - vi. Department in which research is being done
    - vii. Name, address, and telephone number of the research advisor
  - b. Details of the research (no longer than 2 pages)
    - i. Objectives of the research
    - ii. Summary of the research
    - iii. Research techniques to be used
    - iv. Expected results or accomplishments of the research
    - v. Significance of the research to the area of food chemistry
4. The research proposal, recommendation letters and transcripts (undergraduate and graduate; preferably scanned) should be **e-mailed** to:
